MAP YOUR FLUTE

In order to complete these steps:

- 1) You must have an electronic tuner
- 2) You must be able to hold a steady pitch

See the back of the book if you need help holding a pitch steady.

Begin by tuning either the first or second octave "a" with an electronic tuner. Then play each note \bar{F} with no vibrato and have a friend watch the tuner. Choose notes at random for best results. He or she will map the results by placing a dot on the graph for each note. It is best to use a tuner which has a dial marked off in numerical increments. These intonation increments are known as "cents". 10 cents sharp = +10, 10 cents flat = -10. The chart begins with our lowest C and goes up to our highest C.
